(1) requires local governmental units to annually designate a public depository or depositories, which are defined in N.J.S.A. 17:9-41 as: " a State or federally chartered bank, savings bank or an association located in this State or a state or federally chartered bank, savings bank or an association located in another state with a branch office in the State, the deposits of which are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation and which receives or holds public funds on deposit. "; and

**WHEREAS;** the Board has determined that Brunswick Bank & Trust Co. and Sovereign Bank are qualified depositories that are eligible to receive and hold public funds on deposit as permitted by the above referenced statutes; and

**WHEREAS;** it is the opinion of the Board that designating the above identified financial institutions as the official depositories of fire district funds is convenient, necessary and desirable for the business purposes of the Board.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No.1 Englishtown Borough that Brunswick Bank and Trust Co. and Sovereign Bank be and the same are hereby designated as official depositories of District funds for the year 2010.

## PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

### **WITNESSETH:**

1. The Board hereby retains the Attorney to provide legal services to it for the year commencing March 1, 2010 and terminating February 28, 2010, and the attorney agrees to provide such legal services as he is directed to provide by the Board.

5. All payments to be made hereunder shall be made upon submission of an itemized voucher specifying the services rendered and the date upon which such services were rendered on such forms as may be provided by the Board.






amended and supplemented, and the attorney agrees to comply fully with the terms, provisions and conditions of said subsections.
